1.1 1.2	The event is governed by the rules as defined in <i>The Racing Rules of Sailing</i> . The National Squib Class rules		
1.3	Racing rules [35, A4 and A5] will be changed as follows: Boats failing to finish within 15 minutes after the first boat finishes will be scored DNF.		
1.4	No national prescriptions will apply.		
1.5	Competitors should note the Organising Authority implements the RYA Racing Charter and they will be required to undertake to sail in compliance with the Charter, which can be found in the front of the RYA rule book.		
1.6	Competitors and support persons shall comply with any reasonable instructions from an event official.		
2	Sailing Instructions		
2.1	The Sailing instructions will be available on the Felixstowe Ferry Sailing Club notice board located in the clubhouse.		
2.2	The sailing instructions consist of the RRS Appendix 5 Standard Sailing Instructions and the supplementary sailing instructions available at registration.		
3	Communications		
3.1	The official notice board is located in the clubhouse at FFSC		
3.2	All boats may carry a VHF radio capable of communicating on CH72		
3.3	On the water, the race committee will make courtesy broadcasts to competitors on VHF radio.		
3.4	While racing, except in an emergency, a boat shall not make voice		
	or data transmissions and shall not receive voice or data communication that is not available to all boats.		
4	Eligibility and Entry		
4.1	The event is open to all boats of the Squib Class		
4.2	The event is open to all members of the National Squib Owners Association		
4.3	Classes are defined as follows Silver, Gold		
4.4	Eligible boats may enter by completing the entry form on this website, the required fee, must be paid before entry is accepted.		
4.5	Boats may enter the event by downloading the entry form from the FFSC website, completing it, and sending it by post to FFSC as detailed on the entry form.		
4.6	To be considered an entry in the event, a boat shall complete all registration requirements and pay all fees.

- 14.1 The Scoring Penalty, RRS 44.1, applies.
- 15. **Scoring**
- 15.1 Two races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 15.2 If 5 races are not sailed, there will be no discard.
- 16. Support persons vessels
- 16.1 Support person vessels shall be marked Support
- 17. Chartered or loaned boats

- 18.1 Boats shall be kept in their assigned places while in the moorings
- 19. Haulout restrictions
- 19.1 Keelboats shall not be hauled out during the event except with and according to the terms of prior written permission of the race committee
- 20. Diving equipment and plastic pools
- 20.1 Keelboats shall not be cleaned below the waterline by any means during the event
- 21. Data Protection

The management of racing involves the use of participants' personal information. The information you provide to the organising authority will only be used to facilitate your participation in the event. Within the U.K. the use and storage of personal information is regulated by the Data Protection Act 2018

- 22. Risk Statement
- 22.1 RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.
- 23. Insurance
- 23.1 Each participating boat shall be insured with valid third-party liability insurance with a minimum cover of 3 million pounds sterling per incident or the equivalent.
- 24 Prizes
- 24.1 Prizes will be given on Sunday at the end of the event.

25. Further information

- 25.1 It is anticipated that most boats will arrive on Friday 26th for launching. Ay boats arriving on Saturday 26th should indicate this on the entry form. It is anticipated that boats from the rivers Orwell and Deben will sailed to the event, however if any local visitors wish to be launched they should contact the Felixstowe Ferry Boatyard (Andrew Moore) to make their own arrangements. It is unlikely that these local boats will be recovered on Sunday 28th.
- 25.2 Boat numbering stickers will be allocated on registration on Friday/Saturday in the clubhouse. These stickers are to facilitate recovery of boats on Sunday. Competitors will be required to display these stickers on the bow.
